1. 競技の観戦はスターティングホールのみです。

JJGT でも行っているように、スターティングホールでの見物、2番、3番ホール、9番ホール、及び9番ホールより10番(インコース)へ移動する際には、選手に激励の言葉、食べ物、飲み物、常用の薬、アイスノンなどを手渡すことは許されておりますが、選手のキャディバッグ、クラブ類に触れることは禁止されております。当然アドバイスも厳禁です。観戦者はクラブハウス、プロショップ、レストラン、練習用のパッティンググリーン、及びその周辺、ドライビングレンジ(練習場)への立ち入りは認められています。

# 2. 選手の健康管理・緊急の場合

原則として PJO(パールジュニアオープン)大会本部が行います。選手に緊急の場合が起きた場合、協議開催中のコース内に入ることが出来ます。詳しいことは競技が始まる前に JJGT 大会役員にお申しつけ下さい。常備薬を忘れずに!また、暑さ対策も日本を出発される前に充分ご留意ください。

### 3. ドレスコード

- ・男子・女子とも襟付きのシャツを着用し、ズボン、スカートなどにタックインしてください。 スイングのためにシャツが上がってしまう場合もありますが、スイング以外の動きには常 備タックインを心がけてください。
- ・極度に短いショーツは禁止されています。膝上10センチまでが基準となっています。 (余談ですが、USLPGAの選手の中にはこの規定に違反している有名プレーヤーが10 数名います)。
- ・UVCUT(紫外線カット)のサングラスの着用は許可されています。
- ・キャップ・サンバイザーの着用をお勧めします(強制はしていません)。
- 計測器は使用禁止です。
- ・其の他、試合中、練習器具などは誤解の元になりますので、携行しないほうがよいでしょう。

### 4. 練習ラウンド

2日間(7/21日 $\sim$ 22日(土日))を予定しております。あくまでも任意です。

## 5. 試合会場までの交通手段

練習ラウンド及び大会2日間は大型チャーターバスにて団体行動です。遅いティタイム (上の年齢)で一緒に行動しない場合は、自分でタクシーで来場してもらいます。できる限り、Team Mateを応援するためにも同一行動にしましょう。

6. 競技は担ぎか、手引きカートで行います。手引カートの貸し制度はありませんので、日本から持ち込むか、現地で調達する必要があります。

#### 7. 表彰式

2日目の競技終了後 Buffet Banquet にて表彰式が行われます。選手は無料で昼食をとりながら表彰式セレモニーに臨みます。保護者もチップ込みで表彰式に参加できます。もちろん Buffet 式の昼食付です。(進行状況よっては夕食にずれ込む場合があります)

# 2012 PEARL JUNIOR OPEN JULY 23 & 24, 2012 PEARL COUNTRY CLUB LOCAL RULES AND NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

## I. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A. FORMAT OF PLAY is a 36 Hole Stroke Play event. The tournament will be played from the following TEE MARKERS: 10 and under Boys and Girls - Green Tees, 11-12 Boys and Girls -Red Tees, 13-14 Boys and Girls - White Tees, 15-18 Girls - White Tees, and 15-18 Boys - Blue Tees.
- B. YARDAGE MARKERS are measured to the center of the Greens.

Sprinkler Heads: Yardage is shown on the sprinkler heads.

100 Yard Markers: Indicated by red markers embedded in the fairways.

150 Yard Markers: Indicated by yellow markers embedded in the fairways.

200 Yard Markers on Par 5s: Indicated by blue markers embedded in the fairways.

- C. SCORING AREA: Please turn in your signed and attested scorecards to the designated scoring area immediately upon completion of your round.
- D. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE is comprised of 1 Head Rules Official, 1 Rules Official, 2 OJGA Representatives, 1 Pearl Country Club Representative.
- E. DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE: When doubtful of one's rights or a procedure, the player may apply RULE 3-3 and play a second ball without penalty. The player shall report the facts to the Committee before turning in his scorecard unless he scores the same with both balls. Failure to report will result in disqualification. Please review RULE 3-3: DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE.
- F. TIES occurring for first place in any division shall be decided, if possible, by sudden death play-off immediately following completion of the tournament (stroke play rules apply). No playoff hole shall begin after 6:00 p.m. Note: Players should not leave the premises if they may be eligible to participate in a playoff. If the player concerned is not present at the time at which the playoff is to begin, that player will be deemed to have not participated in the playoff. If a sudden death play-off is not possible, then such ties along with all other ties for prize and point positions will be decided by matching of scorecards in the manner stated by the USGA.
- G. DRESS CODE: All players and spectators must adhere to the OJGA Dress Code as stated in the OJGA Handbook located at www.ojga.org.
- H. CODE OF CONDUCT: All players must adhere to the OJGA Code of Conduct.
- RE: "WALKING SPECATORS": Per Pearl Country Club, NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED.
- J. FINAL ROUND TEE TIMES will be posted on <u>www.808golf.com</u>, <u>www.ojga.org</u>, or in the Pearl Country Club Pro Shop. Tee times may also be obtained by calling (808) 392-3807.

# II. CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION:

- A. 2010 USGA Rules of Golf and Local rules on this Notice govern play.
- B. CHECK-IN: All contestants must personally check-in BOTH days with the Tournament Registration Desk (located in front of the Locker Rooms near the Restaurant entrance).
- C. TEE ASSIGNMENTS: All contestants are responsible for their arrival and check-in with the Starter at their assigned tee no later than 10 minutes prior to their assigned tee time.
- D. TIME OF STARTING: Each player must arrive at their starting point, ready to play at the starting time assigned by the Committee. Penalty for breach of this rule is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this competition that if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within 5 minutes after his starting time, and in the absence of circumstances, which warrant the penalty of disqualification, the penalty for failure to start on time shall be 2 strokes at the first hole instead of disqualification.

- E. LIST OF CONFORMING BALLS: Only brands of golf balls on the USGA's list of conforming balls may be used. Penalty for use of a brand NOT on the list is disqualification. The One Ball Rule is not in effect.
- F. EMBEDDED BALL: (USGA Rules, Appendix I) Anywhere "Through the Green", a ball which is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground, except in loose sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.
- G. SLOW PLAY: Check point hole times will be as follows: FRONT NINE: Hole #4 – 1:08, Hole #9 – 2:30, Hole #13 – 3:36, Hole #18 – 5:00 BACK NINE: Hole #13 – 1:06, Hole #18 – 2:30, Hole #4 – 3:38, Hole #9 – 5:00
- H. PRACTICE BETWEEN HOLES: (Appendix 1) Between play of two holes a player shall not play any practice stroke on or near the putting green of the last hole played. This includes the practice putting green located between the #4 green and the 5<sup>th</sup> tee box. Penalty for breach of this condition: Two (2) strokes at the next hole.

### III. LOCAL RULES:

Course Local Rules shown on scorecard or on signs posted anywhere on the playing ground are **NOT** in play unless included in this LOCAL RULES SHEETS.

- A. OUT OF BOUNDS (O.B) are defined by white stakes, white lines or inside edge of fence posts at ground level. When O.B. is defined by a white line on the ground, the line is O.B.
- B. HOLES #17 & #18: Balls hit into the driving range are O.B.
- C. HOLE #7: Out of Bounds on the left and right as marked (Local rule NOT in effect, No Drop Zone)
- D. GROUND UNDER REPAIR is defined by enclosed white lines around the affected area. Players are entitled to relief under USGA Rule 25-1.
- E. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Any area that is marked with white paint adjacent to a cart path is considered an extension of the cart path (immovable obstruction) and player is entitled to relief under USGA Rule No. 24. The flowerbeds behind the green of holes #9 and #12 as well as all irrigation control boxes are considered immovable obstructions and the player is entitled to relief under Rule 24. However, the player is NOT ENTITLED TO RELIEF from the hedges surrounding the irrigation boxes.
- F. LATERAL WATER HAZARD margins are defined by red stakes and/or red lines. Stakes and lines are in the Lateral Water Hazard.
- G. RELIEF FROM LATERAL WATER HAZARD ON HOLE #5: When taking relief from the lateral water hazard on hole #5, where the cart path is immediately adjacent to the lateral water hazard, the player may proceed to the left side of the cart path and drop within one (1) club length of a point no nearer to the hold than where the ball last crossed the margin of the lateral water hazard (ONE STROKE).
- H. RELIEF FROM LATERAL WATER HAZARD BEHIND GREEN ON HOLE #6: If a player's ball is in the area marked as a lateral water hazard behind the green, starting from the water hazard margin marked on the cart path to the right of the green on Hole #6, the player may, as an additional option under Rule 26-1, under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball on the area marked as a Drop Zone to the right of the green.
- WATER HAZARDS are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines. Stakes and Lines are in the water hazard.
- J. RAIN OUT POLICY: In the event that the entire first or second round should be rained out, the tournament shall become an 18-hole event.
- K. RANGE BALLS ON COURSE: The hitting of practice balls back toward the range during the play of a hole will constitute a breach of Rule 7-2.
- L. SHUTTLES: Shuttles may be provided only for the 10 and Under players between holes 4 and 5, 6 and 7, 9 and 10, 11 and 12, and 15 and 16. All other age divisions will be shuttled as deemed necessary by committee.
- M. RANGE FINDERS and ELECTRONIC DEVICES of ANY type are NOT ALLOWED.
